Trump, Putin stand by each other...

In a light-hearted moment, Putin gave Trump a ball from the 2018 World Cup, to symbolise North America hosting the tournament in 2026, saying: “Now the ball is in your court.” Trump, who praised Russia’s hosting of the World Cup, said his son would like the gift and threw it into the audience, where his wife Melania caught it.

Putin said the US and Russia needed to solve problems together and that Moscow was ready for intelligence cooperation with America on terrorism and cyber threats. Agreeing on the need for increased cooperation, Trump said: “If we are going to solve many of the problems facing our world, we will have to find ways to cooperate.”

3rd suspect leptot death

Dr Keskar said as of now, his death is suspected to be due to leptospirosis, as the committee is yet to scrutinise the case. “After analysing the medical aspects of the three probable leptospirosis deaths in June, two of the deaths were determined to be due to leptospirosis. This latest case is yet to be analysed by the committee,” added Keskar.

As per reports from the civic health department, a total of 574 houses and 1,926 people were screened and two cases of fever, two cases of upper respiratory tract infection and three cases of diarrhoeal vomiting were detected and referred to nearby dispensaries. Moreover, in the first 15 days of July 2018, 369 cases of probable dengue or dengue-like illnesses were admitted to various civic hospitals.

He added that he has been constantly monitoring the condition of the roads. “Last year I travelled in almost all the 36 districts of the state to review the work of filling up potholes. Similarly, since last year we are giving a two-year annual maintenance contract wherein the contractor is required to fill up potholes that come up during this period,” he said.

“Besides, all roads in Maharashtra will be of cement concrete (instead of bitumen) in the coming years,” he said.

Certification was required for airing such a web series. The court has listed the matter for July 19 for a detailed hearing.

Last week, a Congress activist in West Bengal filed a police complaint against actor Nawazuddin Siddiqui, media services provider Netflix and the makers of “Sacred Games” for “insulting and abusing” Rajiv Gandhi.

The series is based on author Vikram Chandra’s novel of the same name. It has been directed by Anurag Kashyap and Vikramaditya Motwane.

Breaking his silence over the web series, Congress President Rahul Gandhi on Saturday said the “Bharatiya Janata Party and the Rashtriya Swamsevaks Sangh believe the freedom of expression must be policed and controlled but I feel it is a fundamental democratic right”.

Rape, murder accused let off...

The bench acquitted Gaikwad saying the prosecution had only gathered ‘circumstantial’ evidence against him and failed to connect all the sequences together to establish his guilt.

“Considering the prosecution evidence, it is clear that family members and witnesses are not telling any false stories. However, the case of the prosecution still does not travel beyond suspicion,” the bench said while quashing the judgment pronounced by the Sewree sessions court in October 2010 against Gaikwad.

'Bench-hunter' Hotel Leela told to...

The bench noted the fact that initially the hotel had urged the Acting Chief Justice of the HC to place all its petitions before a division bench, after which, the pleas were listed before Justice Oka’s bench.

However, on Monday when the matter was called out for hearing, the five-star hotel claimed its matter must instead come up before a single-judge bench.

The counsel representing the hotel submitted, “We have filed three petitions, one challenging the eviction notice issued by AAI and another initiating eviction proceedings by the authority. Also, the third one is an arbitration petition.”

“The arbitration petition should be heard by a single-judge bench and not a division bench. Also, the other two petitions can be clubbed along with the arbitration petition,” the counsel for the hotel, had submitted.

The AAI had in February last year issued an eviction notice to the hotel for non-payment of dues. The authority also initiated the process to evict the hotel and reclaim 29,000 sq m land, on which its structure stands. AAI issued the notice claiming the hotel flouted the agreement and had also failed to pay dues.

Meanwhile, the bench also vacated an interim order that it had granted previously, staying the eviction proceedings initiated by AAI against the hotel before an eviction officer. This means, AAI can now proceed with eviction proceedings as per provisions of Airports Authority of India Act.

Rain plays havoc in Kerala, rail and road traffic affected

Rail and road traffic were hit in various parts of Kerala on Monday due to waterlogging as heavy rains continued to pound the state with the South West Monsoon becoming active again.

In the second spell of rains due to the South West monsoon, 11 people have been killed since July 9, according to the state control room, which is monitoring rain-related incidents. Several low-lying areas are inundated and roads are cut off, it said.

Due to waterlogging on rail tracks, signalling system has been affected and at least eight passenger trains have been cancelled and some others are running late in the Ernakulam-Thiruvananthapuram route. Kerala State Road Transport Corporation bus station here is also waterlogged, disrupting services, it said.

Educational institutions in Thiruvananthapuram, Kollam, Pathnamthitta, Alapuzha, Kottayam, Idukki, Er-

nakulam and Thrissur districts are closed today as district collectors declared a holiday due to heavy rains. Kerala University has postponed all its examinations scheduled for tomorrow to July 21.

Cloudburst washes away houses in Chamoli, one killed

DEHRADUN: Several houses, shops and vehicles were swept away following a cloudburst in Tharali and Ghat areas of Chamoli district early on Monday, while a woman died after falling into an overflowing canal in Pithoragarh district in Uttarakhand.

While five houses were damaged in Kundi village, ten houses suffered damage in Maukhmallā village of Ghat area where two animals were also washed away, the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) said here.

About 10-15 shops and ten vehicles including three motorcycles were washed away in Ratgaon in Tharali area of Chamoli district, it said.

MoD panel to probe costlier Made-in-India equipment

Defence Minister Nirmala Sitharaman has constituted a committee headed by the director of costs in her ministry to examine the armed forces’ complaint that most of the military equipment procured from the Indian public sector companies are costlier than the prices quoted by the foreign makers.

The committee has been asked to give its report by August-end as the defence minister doesn’t want the government’s Make-in-India policy get bad name from the forces craving for permission to buy from the original manufacturers unless the defence public sector companies lower their prices.

The first case sent to the committee for examination is from the Indian Air Force on the Hindustan Aeronautics Limited asking for Rs 463 crore a piece for the Tejas

light combat fighter jet Mark1A as against Swedish Gripen offering it at Rs 455 crore and US F-16 still lower at Rs 380 crore and both prepared to assemble them in India. The IAF wanted 83 Tejas jets from HAL, a company owned by the defence ministry.

The Sukhoi fighter which HAL assembles at Nashik is priced at Rs 415 crore while the IAF will get it much cheaper at Rs 330 crore if bought directly from the Russians.

Besides these two aircraft, the committee has been asked to check prices of each equipment of the public sector units.

In 2012, the Tatra truck supplied by Bharat Earth Movers Limited were found to be overpriced. These multi-axel trucks are used to transport missiles.

More recently, the purchase of four warships from Russia has been hit as two of these to

Shashi Tharoor's office vandalised in Kerala

Congress MP Shashi Tharoor’s office here was vandalised on Monday by youth wing activists of BJP, police said, days after he set off a huge row with remarks that the BJP, if voted to power again, will rewrite the Constitution and pave the way for creation of a ‘Hindu Pakistan’.

The Congress Lok Sabha member from the Kerala capital said the BJP and “Sanghi goondas” orchestrated the incident.

"Today @YUWAMORCHABJP vandals attacked my constituency office in Thiruvananthapuram. They poured black engine oil on signs, doors, walls & gate, drove away innocent citizens waiting with their petitions, put up offensive banners and shouted slogans asking me to go to Pakistan," Tharoor tweeted.

Rain: NDRE, Air Force on alert in Guj

AHMEDABAD: Several districts of Gujarat received heavy rainfall resulting in four villages getting marooned in the worst affected Gir Somnath district, even as the NDRE had to be deployed to rescue 70 passengers of a metre gauge train and the Air Force was put on alert.

Asthana cannot represent Alok Verma in selection meetings: CBI

NEW DELHI: The CBI has told the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC) that its Special Director RK Asthana cannot represent its Director Alok Verma during meetings for giving clearance to officials being considered for posting in the agency as his role in various cases is under the “scanner”. The issue came up after the CVC sought the presence of the

CBI director in the selection committee meeting which was to be held on July 12. The CVC said in the absence of the director, an officer holding the charge could be sent. The CBI conveyed to the commission that the charge has not been handed to Asthana who is second in command in the agency.

Fatwa against woman for opposing triple talaq

The Imam of Bareilly’s Jama Masjid on Monday issued a fatwa, a ruling on a point of Islamic law, against a woman who had been opposing several Islamic practices, including Triple Talaq, and demonstrating against the same.
